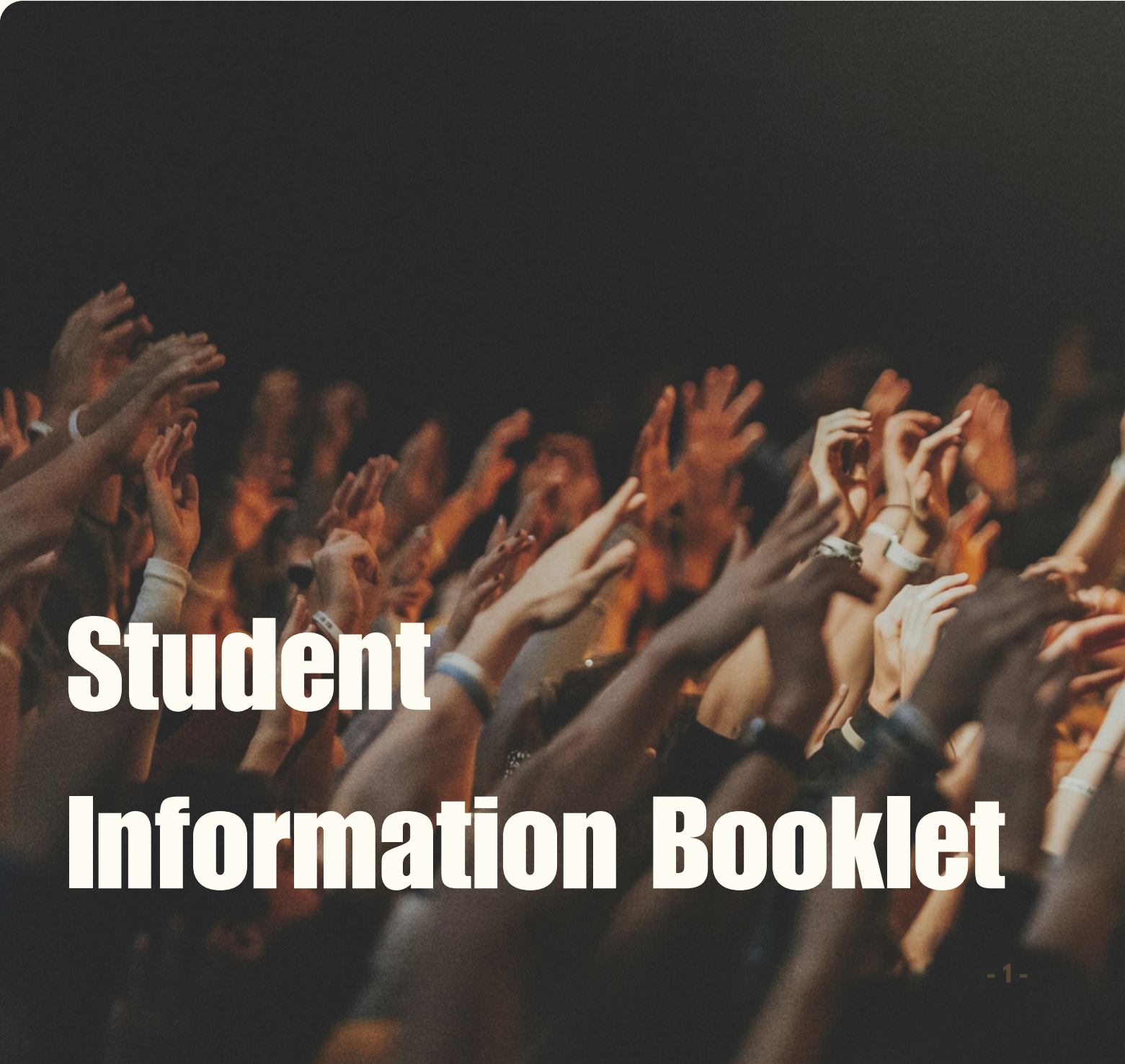

- Anyone and everyone who hungers and thirsts for more of God, wants to encounter the One whose waters truly satisfy, and become a source of that water to those around them.

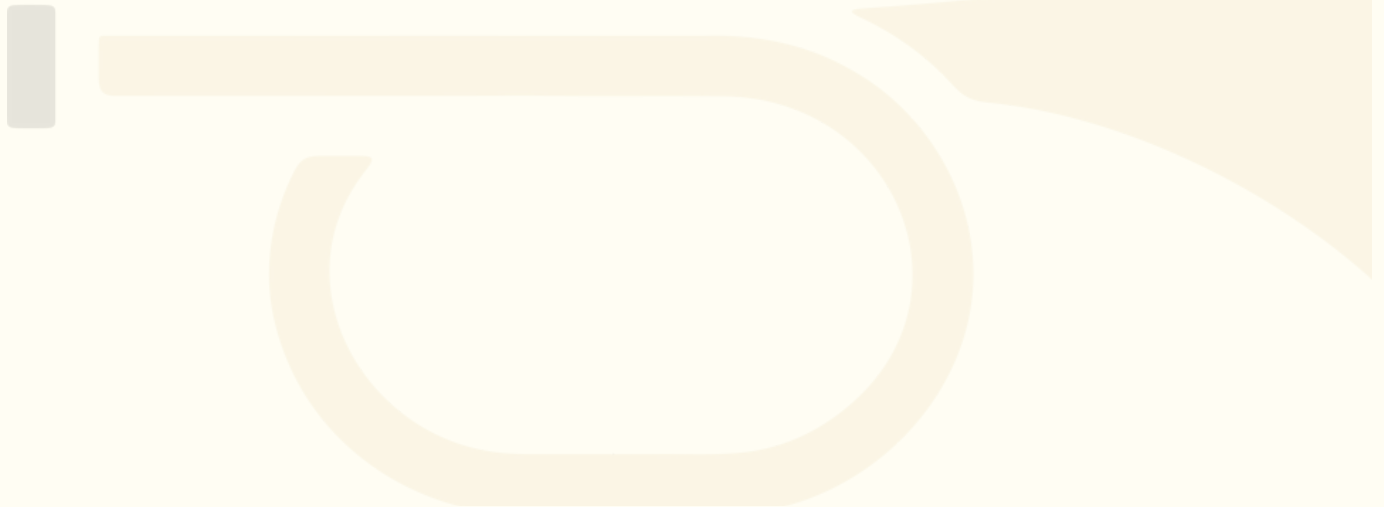

Although the exact order of the class schedule may vary slightly from week to week, it will always take place on the same days each week.

Weekly School Components Total time ≈ 30 hours per week

Prayer

Prayer is the doorway to intimacy with God. We expect our students to maintain their own secret place with the Lord outside of school hours. However, we also have an optional gathering before school each day for those who want to pursue things together in prayer.

Bible

Due to our high value for the scriptures, bible study and exposition is taught nearly every day in school.

Worship

Our primary ministry is to the King. We make praise and worship a central part to nearly every day of school.

Outreach

Each student will sign up for a weekly outreach. Here they will have opportunities to actively put into the practice the things they have learned, step out in faith, and reveal the love of God to the local area.

Revival Groups

Each student is placed into a revival group, and there is dedicated fulltime pastor leading each group. These groups meet once per week, and they provide a sense of community for each student. They also divide up the school into smaller groups so that no one gets lost in the crowd and each student is able to receive one-on-one input and pastoral covering.

Weekly School Components Continued

Small Groups

Each revival group is divided into small groups of about 5 students each. These provide opportunities for students to connect, be vulnerable, and pray in a much more personal way.

Advanced Ministry Trainings (AMTs)

Everyone gets an opportunity to choose additional areas that they would like to grow in. There are multiple advanced ministry trainings (AMTs) offered that provide a more specialized and focused learning environment that vary from class to class

Sunday Services

We believe the local church is central to the advancement of the kingdom of God. Therefore, every student is required to attend a church service on the weekend.

Homework ≈ 4-10 hours per week

Homework is assessed on a pass/fail basis through relationship with each student. We expect each student to take the homework seriously and put their heart into their work. Homework includes daily bible reading, assigned books, topical bible studies, and self reflective questions.

All international students who are residents of a non-African nation are required to pay the standard tuition rate by first day of school.

School fees cover all classes, school books, and local outreaches.

School fees DO NOT cover housing, food, transportation, or international missions trips.
